Fewer than 50 attendees: \$200.00 (new members); \$175.00 (established members) More than 50 attendees: \$375.00 (new members); \$200.00 (established members) Wedding events (rehearsal dinners, reception, etc.): \$375.00
Mon-Thurs rentals are available for established members at \$75.00 off the normal rate.

A deposit of an additional \$100.00 is required; it will be refunded if the renter complies with rental terms and the clubhouse is left in satisfactory condition. There is a refundable clean-up fee of \$60.00. Returned, if cleaning is satisfactory.
